All the students are divided into groups and each group is guided by a lecturer. Every week Mentor classes are conducted and students are given guidance and counseling for their personal and educational problems and issues.

Both prospective teachers and teacher educators are selected by various Institutions even before they complete their course, while they are on the campus and it is our proud privilege because they are the students of this college. The information regarding the various existing vacancies is made available to the students from time to time.

40. Good practices of the institutions:

The college has set a tradition by following some healthy practices which help it to keep in tune with the objectives it has set for itself.

- ❖ Each and every activity in the college curriculum and co-curricular activities aim at the holistic development of the students.
- ❖ The curricular and co-curricular activities are planned and executed very systematically. The teaching practice that is given to the student teachers is supervised by the methodology lecturers. Each student gets a chance of teaching at three different spells and all the teachings are supervised and suggestions are offered. Similarly students are allotted to the local schools for their internship and even during this period the faculty members visit them at the posted schools. This is a practice that has not been diluted in any way during the last 68 years, to be more precise, from the time the college was established in 1946.
- ❖ The teaching aids used and submitted by the student teachers are added to the ones already existing and the surplus aids are distributed in the local schools according to their need. The local schools help in the internship of our students and this is one way of acknowledging their help and saying thank you.

- ❖ Being one of the senior most Colleges of Education, the Institution is always extending a helping hand to the other Colleges of Education by way of arranging demonstration lessons, extension lectures, materials etc.
- ❖ Similarly suggestions and help from the other Colleges of Education which have potential are most welcome. Their modern, creative and practical ideas are always accepted and put into practice. Though the college has age old traditions it is very much open to modern ways.
- ❖ The M.Ed., students, for whom the dissertation work is compulsory, are encouraged to take up studies on problems in vogue and find solutions for the same. In this regard the students are given a lot of help and guidance by the faculty members.
- ❖ Spiritual development and campus ministry, too very important practices of the college give very good results. Many opportunities are provided to the students and staff to inculcate values and develop positive attitude towards ethics, morals, rights and duties.
- ❖ The staff and students come together to celebrate various national and religious festivals with joy and gusto.
- ❖ Days of importance to the staff individually, like jubilees, retirements etc. are also celebrated with enthusiasm.
- ❖ Arranging lunches and dinners on special occasions is customary. Christmas is a very important day for all in the college and so is 19th of March our patron St. Joseph's Feast Day.
- ❖ Community service is mandatory to the students and also the staff of the college. The areas of importance are the various social problems and creating awareness in the people towards them and helping them to solve the same.
- ❖ Mentor groups are maintained, whereby a group of 20 students is entrusted to the care of one faculty member, who helps them in various needs and provides guidance and counseling. There is also a Question Box and 'May I help you' counter through which the students can get clarifications.
