

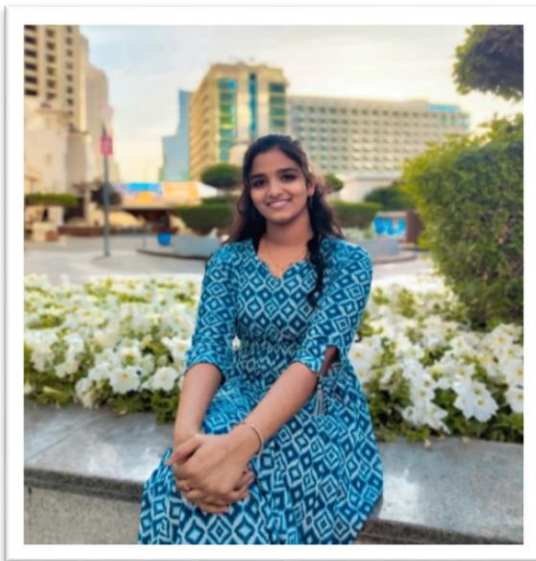

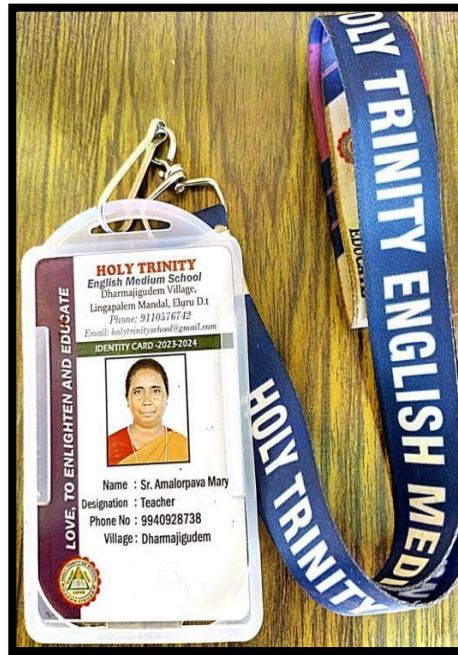


I am Kalyani P, a proud alumna from the batch of 2021 to 2023 of St. Joseph's College of Education for Women, Guntur.

The teaching methodologies and practical experiences I gained here have been instrumental in my role as an educator.

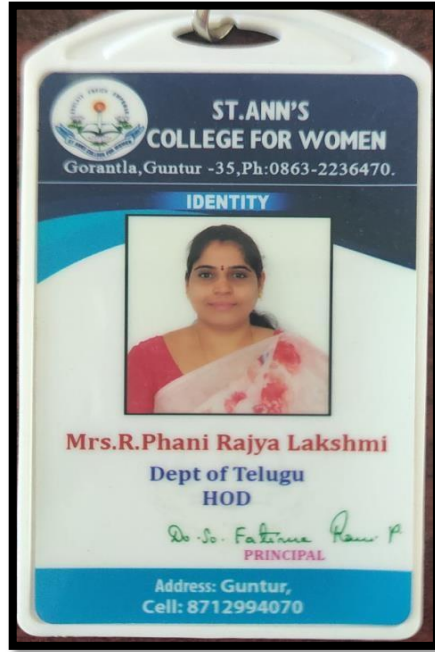
